

How to comment on the Salisbury District Council Core Strategy Preferred Options

The local development framework

Salisbury District Council is preparing a Local Development Framework (LDF). The LDF is a series of documents which will eventually replace the Salisbury Local Plan that was adopted in 2003 and set out planning policies which promote and control development throughout the district. This document builds on the consultation process we carried out between July and October 2007, where we asked you to comment on a range of issues and options for tackling the challenges the district faces.

Having analysed the comments received for the consultation in the summer we have produced the core strategy preferred options. The core strategy will provide the overarching planning policies for the district for the next 20 years. Public consultation on the Core strategy preferred options runs between **28 February 2008** and **11 April 2008**.
